Simon Speight, supporter of The Prince of Wales Hospice has given his time to support hospice care and motivate others, despite his own life challenge.

He has completed lots of challenges and already raised over $\pm 3,200$ for the Hospice. Now he is training for his next challenge, to run a marathon and he hopes to inspire others by sharing his story.

"I started raising funds for The Prince of Wales Hospice after witnessing first-hand the love and care they provided to my sister who sadly left us on 30 April 2021, after only seven weeks and two days from being diagnosed with an aggressive brain tumour. From that moment I wanted to ensure others benefit from the same loving care when they need it most."

"My wife and I had recently got into running and so I planned a number of challenges to help with my fundraising. My first challenge was running 10km every day for 10 days, which I completed successfully. I even had people join me on some of the runs and one day someone handed me a donation. By mid-May 2021 I had raised £1,935. I was blown away by the level of support and generosity, and this just motivated me to carry on."

"The following month I completed the Pontefract 10k, and then things got serious when I signed up for the Great North Run (half marathon). My training was going great, I felt more than ready. Then, the week before the Great North Run, my whole life turned upside down. I ended up in hospital with something I had never even heard of, Pancreatitis. This led to other critical conditions and spent many weeks in hospital and another three months of recovery before returning back to work. As result I have lost half my pancreas, can no longer drink alcohol and ended up being a diabetic."

"However, I was determined to not let any of that stop me from returning to my fundraising challenges. I was able to defer the Great North Run to this year so you can imagine what I was thinking, how do I get fit enough between April and September."

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"I adopted a training method called jeffing (jeffgalloway.com) which is a combination of running and walking, this was learned at my running club – Ackworth Road Runners – they have been excellent throughout the training."

"I "jeffed" the Pontefract 10k in May, I "jeffed" the Doncaster Half marathon in June, I then completed The Prince of Wales Hospice challenge event – the Yorkshire 3 Peaks with my wife, Rachael. That was the hardest thing I have done in my whole life."

"And on Sunday, 11 September 2022, I completed the Great North Run in 2 hrs 30 mins."

"I am still blown away by the amount of support I've had throughout my whole fundraising journey and cannot thank people enough. The Prince of Wales Hospice is such a great cause and they have been so supportive."
