Year two of the HARIBO Happiness Together Fund, in conjunction with Prosper Wakefield, is now open for applications from community groups, charities, and social enterprises across the Wakefield District.

In partnership with HARIBO, the Community Foundation Wakefield District are appealing for projects and applications that encourage friendships across generations. Activities can range from improving the facilities available within the local community to delivering events and activities that bring young and older people together.

Murray Edwards, Foundation Director, says 'The HARIBO Happiness Together Fund has enjoyed a great start, supporting seven amazing projects during its first year of funding. We are now looking for the next projects to fund.' The effort paid off, as the team was able to raise over £1,200 for the children's cancer charity. The funds will go towards supporting families in the UK affected by childhood cancer.



SECOND SPECIALITY COFFEE ROASTERY OPENED IN THE HEART OF WAKEFIELD

Recent Beans are proud to announce the opening of their second speciality coffee roastery. A brand-new, customer facing coffee roastery in the heart of the district, in Wakefield city centre. After opening our doors in The Queen's Mill, Castleford for the first time in December 2020, Recent Beans is proud to now be a key part of the local coffee culture, working with both customers and local businesses to improve the quality of coffee brewed in our area. During this time, we've some fantastic partnerships, created friendships, with our regular customers and other local businesses, including a partnership with local Rugby League team, the Castleford Tigers, with the launch of 'Tiger Blend'.

Recent Beans brand motto is that freshly roasted coffee is just better. We've never understood when the biggest selling coffees in supermarkets or big-chain coffee shops are coffees that have been stored for months, or years, on a shelf. Coffee tastes completely different in the first two weeks after it is roasted. Fresh coffee has flavour notes that will disappear if stored too long and the coffee extracts so much better fresh. Once you've tasted really fresh coffee, you never return to old beans.

We wanted to really showcase freshly roasted coffee so we decided we would do it the hard way, we would roast all our coffees daily, on small-batch speciality coffee roasters. Many roasters will roast beans once or twice a week in a large capacity roaster and send out from stock. While this is obviously better than supermarket beans, you can lose those amazing first few days after the roast, we won't do that. Small batches roasted daily.

Recent Beans strays from the mould of other coffee roasters by operating out of working roasteries, open to the public, as both a retail stores and espresso bars. For too long, the magic of coffee roasting has been kept away, behind lock and key, with roasters going above and beyond to keep their secrets. The sights, sounds and smells of a working coffee roastery are magical and deserve to be enjoyed by all coffee lovers. We actively make our roasteries inviting and welcoming places to visit, with a retail store, espresso bar and demonstration areas. We want all our customers to experience the fresh coffee revolution. Whether that be by visiting our roasteries and sampling coffee at our espresso bar, ordering through our website or visiting one of our hospitality partners in the district. We look forward to further ingraining ourselves into the local coffee culture with the opening of our new roastery on Westgate and are excited to welcome new regular customers & work alongside cafes and bars in the city.

Our new roastery officially opened on Friday 17th February at 10am by Councillor Denise Jeffery, in line with the recent Rhubarb Festival. To celebrate opening during the festival, we launched an exclusive Kenyan Peaberry coffee, which has natural taste notes of Rhubarb with a deep chocolate body and fruity acidity (this coffee will only be available in our Wakefield roastery, while stocks last). We also served a menu of rhubarb spiked coffees through our espresso bar and look forward to welcoming everybody to our new roastery and are excited to add to the Recent Beans family.


Growing a carer friendly culture - Support employees who care

This week I have been doing some work with a carers charity that I am a trustee for. Many of you may be carers and Carers UK estimates that there are over 10 million unpaid carers in the UK. That's about 1 in 5 of us.

Being a carer can bring a lot of joy for both the carer and those being cared for, but it can be stressful, make being in paid employment more difficult and bring money worries too.

Carers are often so busy looking after the persor they care for that they forget to look after themselves and don't realise when their own physical and mental health is suffering.

Many employers now have carer support schemes to support carers to continue to work alongside their caring role. If you don't yet have a scheme in your workplace, you could refer your manager to Carers UK who have a programme called Employers For Carers. They provide information to companies about how to create a carer-friendly workplace and offer digital resources to get them started. Carers UK also provide help and support for carers who want to return to work. You can find out more at www.carersuk.org.

Working carers can also sign-up to a FREE 12week virtual peer support programme for people who want to make a positive life-change.
